DISMANT, M.D. -The Dismant family is traced through a long line of ancestors, the first representative, named Daniel, having emigrated from Ireland in 1698. Benjamin F. Dismant was the son of John and Deborah Dismant, and was born on the 27th of February, 1810, in Upper Providence township, Montgomery, where his boyhood was spent upon a farm owned by his father. He early displayed a predilection for study, and enjoyed more than the ordinary advantages of education, attending first public and private schools near his home, and later the Washington Hall Collegiate Institute, at the Trappe, and a similar school in Philadelphia, under the direction of L. Fairchild, Esq. For a brief period he engaged in teaching, and then began the study of medicine with Dr. John A. Jacks, of Berks, and later with Dr. Hugh Lennox Hodge, of Philadelphia. On the completion of his course of lectures he, graduated from the University of Pennsylvania (medical Department) in March 1867. Removing at once to Limerick Centre, he began the practice of his profession, and has never since changed his field of labor. Dr. Dismant soon entered upon a successful career as a practitioner, his thorough knowledge of the science of medicine having afforded the groundwork of this success. From the nature of his field of operation, however, his practice is necessarily general rather than special. The doctor was married, on the 10th of February, 1875, to Mary M., daughter of Henry Walt, of Limerick Township, and has children Lizzie Nellie Georgie John.

Dr. Dismant is a member of the Pottstown Medical Society, frequently participating in the discussions and reading interesting papers before that body. In politics he is a Democrat, but while earnest in his zeal for the advancement of the party interests, he has no ambition for office" (Theodore W.
